# **ACADEMICS & EXAMINATIONS:**

# **SPORTS:**

Sports is an integral part of our curriculum and we conduct various sports activities, class wise for Grades 1 to 4 and House wise for V-X in Juniors & Seniors category respectively.

We conduct inter house competitions in Throw ball, Kho-Kho, Tenni Coite, Volley ball, and Kabaddi throughout the year.

Our Annual Athletic Meet for classes I – IV was held on 10<sup>th</sup> December 2022 in the school ground and for classes V – X it was held on 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2022 at K H Patil Stadium, Gadag. Sri Vidyanand Nayak, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Gadag and Sri Vittal Jabagoudar, Assistant Director, Department of Youth Empowerment And Sports, Gadag were the Chief Guest and Guest of Honour respectively for the Opening Ceremony & Sri H S Basavaraj, Athletic Coach and National level Silver medalist, Asst. This year for **classes I – IV** we have conducted various competitions in Drawing, Singing, English Calligraphy, English Speech, Story Telling, Fancy Dress, Memory Test, Spell Bee and many more and **For Classes V – X** we have conducted Dance competition, Debate competition, Clay Modelling, Fun games on Children's day, Rangoli, Bouquet making competition, Vegetable carving, Poster Making, Food without fire, General Quiz, Kite making, Mathematics & Science quiz competition and many more for children, I am happy to say that **about 85% – 90%** of students have participated in these competitions.
