Bala Vinayaka Vidyaniketan, Gadag, began its journey in **1985**, and since then, we have continuously strived to become better every year. Our BVV community has grown significantly over time. This year, we have a total strength of **1,055 students** and **102 staff members** working hand-in-hand to provide a holistic and futuristic education.

Academics and Examinations:

In the previous academic year, we had **980 students**, and the results were exceptional. The school reopened on **3rd June 2024**, and so far, students have appeared for **21 weekly tests**, conducted every Monday. The First Term Examinations were completed in **October**, and the Annual Examinations will take place in **March 2025**. Following the CBSE guidelines, our examination pattern for Grades I to X ensures comprehensive assessment and learning. Our **eighth batch of Grade X** students appeared for the AISSE Board Examinations from **15th February 2025**.

Celebrations:

Beyond academics, we celebrated important occasions like International Yoga Day, BVV's Foundation Day, Independence Day, National Sports Day, Teachers' Day, Gandhi Jayanti, Children's Day and many more throughout the year to foster patriotism, discipline, and cultural awareness among our students.

Sports and Physical Education:

Sports are an integral part of our curriculum. This year, we conducted various sports activities class-wise forGrades 1 to 4 and house wise for Grades 5 to 10in the Juniors & Seniors categories, respectively

Students participated in inter-house competitions in Throwball, Kho-Kho, TenniCoite, Volleyball, and Kabaddi.Our Annual Athletic Meet for Grades III to X was held on 6th and 7th December 2024 in the school premises. The opening ceremony was graced by Dr. ShridharKuradagi, Consultant General & Laparoscopic Surgeon at Aashraya Hospital, Gadag, and the closing ceremony by Dr. BheemsinghSamorekar, Orthopedic Surgeon, Gadag.

The following students were declared as General Champions:

- Juniors Category: Kumar Gautam Gangarahutar from Grade VI C, and Kumari Shreya Huchannavar from Grade VII B
- Seniors Category: Kumar Md.Aifaz Murad Khan from Grade X Cand Kumari Harshini K from Grade VIII C

Yellow House emerged victorious, bagging the overall championship in Athletics and the Sports Championship for the year **2024-25**.

Inter-School Events:

163 students from classes 3rd to 10th participated in the inter-school "Art for Sewa" competition, organised by the Dwarakamai Foundation, for fundraising to help the underprivileged. Our student, KumarilsraabanuVaddattifrom Grade VI C, secured 2nd place in category two at the inter-school level.

At the school level, the following students received the Best Art Awards:

Our students participated in the **HDNKS inter-school sports** competitions held in **Gadag, Hubli-Dharwad, and Hulkoti**. I am delighted to share the following achievements:

- Our boys' team won the **U-14 Kho-Kho Tournamentwith Kumar Wahid Gonal** receiving the **Best Chaser Trophy**.
- In **U-14 Athletics**the following students won medals:
 - KumariPratikshaRangareddi secured 1st Place in Shot Put
 - Kumar VenkateshKalamani stood 3rd in Shot Put
- Kumar AnkushWarkar&KumariHarshini K bagged 3rd Place in 400m Running
- In **U-17 Volleyball (Girls):**KumariRithuJayaramannavar won the Best Lifter Trophy.

These achievements are a result of the combined efforts of our students, teachers, and parents. We extend my heartfelt gratitude to all the parents for their cooperation and support during all the inter-school events,

especially in conducting after-school sports practice for the students in the school team.

Co-Curricular Activities:

Co-curricular activities play a vital role in a child's holistic development.

- For Grades I to IV, competitions such as Drawing, Singing, Calligraphy, Storytelling, Fancy Dress, Memory Test, Show and Tell, Paper Plate Art, and Socks Puppet Making were conducted.
- **For Grades V to X**, activities included Dance, Debate, Rangoli, Innovation Challenge, Poster Making, Mock Parliament, Rakhi Making, Pot Painting, General Quiz, and Science& Mathematics Quiz.

I am proud to share that **85% to 90%** of our students enthusiastically participated in these competitions.

Self-Governance Day:

On **5th September**, students of Grade X successfully managed the administration of the school for half a day, including teaching classes. This initiative helps inculcate leadership and responsibility among students.

School Elections:

The elections for School Pupil Leader and Assistant School Pupil Leader were held on **14th June 2024**, following the procedures of the parliamentary elections. **Grade IX** students performed an **Election Awareness Skit**, and posters were prepared to support the candidates. Our Vice Principal, Sri PramodsinghByali, designed a software prototype of an Electronic Voting Machine for the elections.

Joy of Giving Club:

This year, we launched the **Joy of Giving Club** in association with the **Dwarakamai Foundation** to inculcate service-mindedness amongst BVV'ians. The students of the club visited various government schools to distribute

notebooks and stationeries. They also visited **Arunodaya**, a special school, where they engaged in bonding activities with the kids and donated sports and teaching aids to the school. Our students have further donated **X books** to the school library on their birthdays and contributed **Rs. 00,000** to the food donation programme of the Dwarakamai Foundation. We sincerely thank the parents for supporting this new initiative and encouraging our students to make a positive impact on society.

AISSE Board Examination Results:

In the **2024 AISSE examinations**, we achieved a 100% pass percentage. Out of **46 students**:

- **21** students secured **Distinction**.
- 10 students passed with First Class.
- 11 students passed with Second Class.
- 4 students secured an Average Pass.

Our **school topper** was **Kumar BalajiPanagantisecured 88.6%.** Subject-wise toppers are as follows:
